Impact of support 2015/16

Early Years - outcomes for disadvantaged pupils is significantly above disadvantaged pupils nationally.

KS1

Reading - disadvantaged pupils achieved 5% greater than national disadvantaged pupils and FSM pupils achieved 8% greater than FSM pupils nationally at expected standard. At greater depth school was 4% below national.

Writing - disadvantaged pupils achieved 1% greater than disadvantaged pupils nationally and FSM pupils achieved 4% greater than the FSM pupils nationally at expected standard. At greater depth school was 6% below national.

Maths - disadvantaged pupils achieved 7% greater than disadvantaged pupils nationally and FSM pupils achieved 5% greater than FSM pupils nationally at expected standard. At greater depth school was 5% below national.

KS2

Reading - disadvantaged pupils achieved 0.2 points greater than disadvantaged pupils nationally and the same for FSM pupils

Maths - disadvantaged pupils achieved 1.0 less than disadvantaged pupils nationally and FSM pupils achieved 1.1 points less than FSM pupils nationally.

Being in line or better than national at greater depth in Reading, Writing and Maths will be a focus for all pupils in school in 2016/17. Class targets for next year will reflect this focus.

Counselling from Wigan Family Welfare has given pupils and their families essential additional support through difficult times and this will continue to be provided next year. The Pastoral support Manager manages and

evaluates the service.
