With support from parents, all pupils are expected to:


- Follow the school rules

Parents' & Carers' Responsibilities

Parents and Carers are expected to:

- Respect school staff and each other
- Ensure that children have a good night's sleep, eat breakfast and are dressed appropriately
- Ensure that children are on time and attend regularly unless they are ill
- Attend teacher/parent meetings and help their children meet the targets set
- Support the homework policy by helping with any work or project set ie Learning Logs
- Ensure that the school always has up- to- date telephone numbers in case of emergency
- Inform school before 9.00am if children are to be absent
