



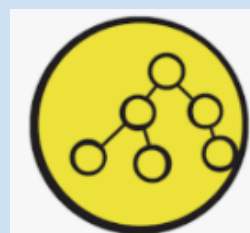
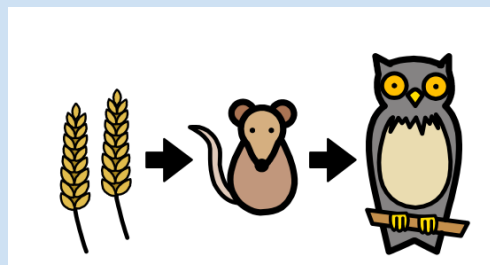
Living Things and Their Habitats



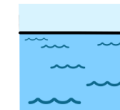
Vocabulary

Habitat	The natural home of an animal or plant. It provides living things with everything they need to survive.
Microhabitat	A very small, specific part of a larger habitat where minibeasts and plants live.
Food chain	It shows who eats whom, starting with a plant (producer) and ending with a bigger animal (predator).
Air	An invisible gas all animals need to breathe to stay alive.
Survive	To stay alive and healthy by having all your basic needs met
Shelter	A safe place that protects living things from bad weather (like rain and wind) and keeps them safe from danger

Food Chains



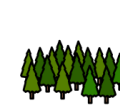
